APPLICATION having been made to the Labour Relations Board (Nova Scotia) on June 21, 1972, for Certification of the Applicant as Bargaining Agent pursuant to the Trade Union Act;

AND the Board having considered the Application on July 17, 1972;

AND the Board having satisfied itself that a majority of the employees of the Respondent in the Bargaining Unit requested are members in good standing of the Applicant in accordance with Regulation 3A (1) Governing Procedure of the Board;

AND that the Unit requested is an appropriate one for Collective Bargaining purposes;

THEREFORE, the Labour Relations Board (Nova Scotia) does hereby certify Labourers' International Union of North America, Local 615, Halifax, Nova Scotia, as the Bargaining Agent for a Bargaining Unit consisting of all employees of the Respondent engaged as Labourers on mainland Nova Scotia, but excluding all other employees, Foremen other than Working Foremen, and those equivalent to the rank of Foreman and above, Office Employees, and those excluded by Clause (i) and (ii) of Paragraph (j) of Section 1 of the Trade Union Act.
