APPLICATION having been made to the Labour Relations Board (Nova Scotia) on May 17, 1978, for Certification of the Applicant as Bargaining Agent pursuant to the Trade Union Act;

AND the Board having conducted a vote on May 25, 1978, in accordance with Section 24 (1) of the Trade Union Act, R.S.N.S. 1972, c.19, s.24, as am. by S.N.S. 1977, c.70;

AND the Application having been contested by the Respondent;

AND the Board having considered the Application and documents filed by the Applicant and Respondent, and representations made and evidence presented on behalf of the parties at a Hearing held on June 17, 1978;

AND the Board having been satisfied that more than forty percent of the employees of the Respondent in an appropriate Bargaining Unit are members in good standing of the Applicant in accordance with Regulation 10 Governing Procedure of the Board;

AND the Board having been satisfied that the majority of those employees voting in the Unit determined by the Board to be appropriate, cast ballots in favour of the Applicant Trade Union;

THEREFORE, the Labour Relations Board (Nova Scotia) does hereby certify the Kentville Local of the Nova Scotia Nurses' Union, Halifax, Nova Scotia, as the Bargaining Agent for a Bargaining Unit consisting of all full-time and regular part-time Registered, Graduate, and Grace Graduate Nurses of Kentville Hospital Association, Kentville, Nova Scotia, but excluding Head Nurses, Supervisors, Director of Nursing, and those persons excluded by Paragraphs (a) and (b) of Subsection 2 of Section 1 of the Trade Union Act. Reasons will be issued at a later date on the issue of the exclusion of Head Nurses.
